Soar Into a Career as an Aviation Mechanic

Governor JB Pritzker visited Rockford recently to announce a \$2.6 million investment to fast-track training for in-demand aviation mechanics, expanding training through AAR's maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO) facility at the Rockford Airport. The expansion will lead to the hiring of 250 aviation mechanics and expand AAR's partnership with Rock Valley College and area high schools.

Bike and Walk More Easily in Downtown Rockford

Rockford received a \$16.5 million federal grant to begin transforming our downtown into a more walkable and bicycle-friendly area. The grant will fund street renovations and lighting, plus recharging facilities and three electric buses, better connecting families to work, school and recreation. Rockford was one of just 680 communities nationwide to receive the grant out of 9700 applicants.



Rockford Doing More to Help Small Businesses

With my full support, the Rockford City Council forgave more than \$932,000 in federally funded loans to small businesses in Rockford hit hard by the pandemic and continuing to struggle due to supply chain issues and labor shortages. The City followed federal guidelines in converting the loans into grants. Half of the businesses are owned by women and 67% are owned by minorities.
