Rockford on the Road to Better Roads

Over the next five years, the City of Rockford will invest more than \$62 million in repaving residential streets and alleys as part of the 2022-2026 Capital Improvement Program. The plan also provides \$10 million for pedestrian and bicycle riding improvements and more than \$3 million to improve stormwater facilities.

Free Bus Rides for Students and Veterans

Starting January 3, 2022, veterans and students in grades K-12 will be able to ride on RMTD bus routes for free, giving individuals the opportunity to more easily access work, education, appointments and recreation. To ride free, students need to present a school-issued ID or an RMTD ID card. Veterans need to present an RMTD ID card. RMTD ID cards can be obtained at the RMTD Transfer Center, 520 Mulberry Street in downtown Rockford.



Javon Bea Hospital Closes Medical/Surgery/ER at Rockton Ave. Location—Hearing Requested

I have put in a formal request to the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board for a public hearing related to the application submitted by Javon Bea Hospital and Mercy Health Corporation to discontinue the 70-bed medical surgical category of service at Javon Bea Hospital on Rockton Avenue. I expect a hearing to be held in January. The Arts Impact the Local Economy

An economic impact study on the arts industry in Northern Illinois found that investment in the arts leads to more job creation and economic growth in other industries.

According to the report, in 2021 the arts industry created \$144 million in economic output in Winnebago County and that investment created \$84 million in economic activity in other areas of the economy including construction, real estate, manufacturing, hospitality, local government and retail. These results can help secure funding for our area arts organizations and reaffirm our belief that the arts play a critical role in our community.
